
A smith of SHIMOSA SAKURA, his father, MASAHIRA, was the brother of MASAYOSHI(1). He learned at the forge of his cousin, MASAYOSHI(2), and had his reputation by KA-EI 1848. His passing is noted in 1878. This robust KATANA reveals his work at the height of his career, dated late in 1865. BO-HI and long NAKAGO enchance its strong lines. SHIRA-KE UTSURI drifts over tightly knit and serene KO-ITAME JI-HADA where searching ASHI-NAGA etch NIOI-DEKI KO-CHOJI that push starkly from the gentle MIDARE rise and fall. KO-NIE stands in the HABUCHI. The jagged BOSHI cuts across its broad KISSAKI to a TOGARI head, and drops long.

In full polish and SHIRA-SAYA with TOKUBETSU HOZON.
